



New and Improved Digital Banking Arriving in 2024



Our digital banking systems are expected to be updated in February of 2024! This means both the mobile and online versions of virtual banking will look a little different. Added security layers such as multi-factor authentication will be included in the upgrade, as well as convenience features such as accessing both the mobile and online versions using only one username and password. Please note that **both** primary **and** joint account owners will need to ensure the information below is current and correct for **each** account holder. This information is essential for access to the new digital banking systems along with enhancing your experience for existing products and services. Although the same username and password will be used for both systems, this only applies to each person on the account. This means there will be separate logins needing to be set up for each individual on the account, thus different login credentials will be necessary for each user.

Board of Directors Volunteers Wanted

VOLUNTERS

We evelcome those who have a passion for the credit union movement and are interested in creating a positive impact for those in their community to serve as a volunteer on the Board of Directors. This is a great opportunity to engage in the general direction of our credit union. To follow the protocol specified in the bylaws of the credit union, the necessary forms must be completed and received by 1st Liberty no later than **February 9, 2024**. Nominations for vacancies may be made by petition signed by 1% of the membership. The election will not be conducted by ballot and there will be no nominations from the floor when there is only one nominee for each position to be filled.

The duties of the Board of Directors are to oversee the general operation of the credit union, to set policy, and to adhere to the bylaws and federal regulations that govern federal credit unions. The volunteer committees support the Board of Directors. Interested individuals should display a strong sense of responsibility, a desire to promote the credit union mission, and have knowledge in some area of credit union activity. Ideal candidates should have a background in finance and/or business, be willing to donate 2-5 hours a month to serve, be bondable and be able to be approved by the NCUA. Board members are elected for a two year term and are scheduled to attend monthly board meetings, annual meeting, and strategic planning sessions. All members, 18 or older, are eligible to hold any office in the credit union and may be appointed to serve on committees.
